

Framed BOO

Quirky and cute, this big "BOO" is sure to be a hit in your Halloween home.



1. Apply Gesso to papier-mâché letters and allow to dry. Paint narrow sides of "B" and 9½" "O" with gloss black paint. Two or more coats may be needed for good coverage.
2. Using letters as patterns, trace "B" and large "O" on right side of fabric or paper scrap. Cut out letters on drawn line. Glue cutouts to face of prepared letters.
3. Wrap fabric scrap around shadow box back board and secure with glue. Insert 9½" "O" into shadow box and replace covered backing.
4. For 6" "O", cover cardboard mat with fabric or paper scrap. Insert mat next to glass of shadow box. Cover shadow box back board with fabric or paper and glue "O" in position desired to backing. Insert into shadow box and secure backing.
5. Display on a shelf or table for a fun Halloween accent.

Materials Needed

11½" Papier-mâché "B"

9½" Papier-mâché "O"

6" Wood "O"

Two 9¾" Square Shadow Boxes

One 9" Cardboard Matte with 5¾" Square Opening

Assorted Fabric and Paper Scraps in Halloween Colors

Gesso

Gloss Black Acrylic Paint

Assorted Paintbrushes

Permanent Adhesive Glue Stick
